13. Are there any physical characteristics that run in your family? Were there a lot of people in the family who resembled each other? What were the most outstanding family characteristics?
14. Who was the oldest relative you remember as a child? What do you remember about them?

16. Are there any special heirlooms, photos, bibles or other memorabilia that have been passed down in your family?

## Early Childhood

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17. Tell me about your childhood home. Describe your room. How many rooms? Bathrooms? Did it have electricity? Indoor plumbing? Telephones?
18. Were there any special items in the house that you remember?
19. What is your earliest childhood memory?
20. Describe a typical family dinner. Did you all eat together as a family? Who did the cooking? What were your favourite foods?
21. Did you have family chores? What were they? Which was your least favourite?
22. Did you receive an allowance? How much? Did you save your money or spend it?
23. What kind of games did you play growing up?
24. What was your favourite toy and why?
25. Did you have any pets? If so, what kind and what were their names?
26. What activities did the family do together? Vacations?
27. What did you do on Christmas? Thanksgiving? Birthdays? Other holidays? Did you family have special traditions?
28. Describe the community you grew up in.

29. What was school like for you as a child? What did you like about it? What was hard about it for you? What were your best and worst subjects? Where did you attend grade school? High school?
30. What was your religion growing up? What church, if any, did you attend?
31. Were you involved in any extracurricular activities? What were they?
32. What did you do in your spare time? Hobbies? Sports? Games?
33. What kind of clothes did you wear everyday? On special occasions?
34. What did you want to be when you grew up?
35. Who were your childhood heroes?
36. What were your favourite songs and music? Books?
37. Were you ever mentioned in a newspaper?
38. Who were your friends when you were growing up?
39. What world events had the most impact on you while you were growing up? Did any of them personally affect your family?

## Adulthood
